Lagos is among the top ten of the world's fastest-growing cities and has the fourth-highest GDP in Africa at \$145.1 billion.



Nigeria is the biggest market for used cars in Africa, and is also one of the most affluent in the Sub-Saharan region.



In 2024, Nigeria alone spent \$11bn on importing vehicle parts.



The Nigerian automotive market is projected to be worth \$27.7bn by 2030, an annual growth rate of 5% from 2025.
